HOW TO PAY

To discover who is responsible for making your payments, log into MY180.com or through the Orion180 Mobile App. Then select *Policy Number* \gg *Finance* and discover if you or the mortgage/escrow has been set up to make payments.

WHEN TO PAY

The first payment is due prior to the effective date of your policy. If you do not pay your bill on-time, payments are subject to late fees.

*All ACH/Wire transactions must reference the policy number

This option does not apply for payments made by Mortgage/Escrow. We accept Visa, Mastercard, and Discover for all online and phone payments. *When your homeowner's insurance policy payment is managed by a third party, such as your lender or servicer, it is referred to as "Escrow billed". You are responsible for getting in contact with your lender about your Escrow billing.
